### Quilt Show Entry Information (REV 0626)

#### How many quilts may I enter?

There is no limit on the number of quilts you may enter.

#### What is the entry fee?

To have a quilt judged, the entry fee is \$5.00 for the first quilt and \$2.00 for each additional quilt.

If you wish to simply display your quilt, the fee is \$3.00 for the first quilt and \$2.00 for each additional quilt.

Fees include admission to the show.

#### How do I enter my quilt?

An entry form for each quilt entered is required, along with the entrance fee(s), picture of quilt(s) (for identification purposes during pick-up), and a 3"x5" card giving your quilt's "history" to share with our guests viewing your quilt at the show.

All entry forms must be postmarked by Friday, September 19, 2008.

#### When/where do I bring (mail) my quilt?

Items for exhibit should be hand-delivered to the Pinery Room in the Portage County Public Library, 1001 Main St., Stevens Point, Wisconsin between the hours of 10 a.m. and 7 p.m. on Wednesday, September 24. No item will be accepted for registration after 7 p.m. on Wednesday, September 24, 2008.

Individuals who are mailing their quilts for exhibit should mail them to Deb Kunst, 1596 Rosewood Circle, Stevens Point, WI 54481. Shipped items must be **received** by Wednesday, September 24, 2008. If you want your quilt shipped back to you, please enclose a check (payable to Star Point Quilters) for postage.

#### How should I prepare my quilt for exhibition in the show?

Every entry must have a fabric label with the quilter's name, address and phone number, legibly printed or typed in indelible ink and sewn to the back of the quilt. Quilts must also have a 4" rod pocket sewn across the top back of the quilt for display.

#### What about judging/awards?

Awards for 1st, 2nd, and 3rd place (and possible Honorable Mention) will be given for each category.

Additional award categories are *Best of Show, Workmanship, Original Design, Show Committee Favorite, Mayor's Choice, Viewers' Choice, Quilt Challenge, and Youth.*

The judge's decisions are final. You will receive a comment sheet from the judge when you claim your quilt at the end of the show.

#### Will my quilt be safe?

The facility we are using has a security system in the building after hours. All quilts will be returned to owners upon receipt of claim ticket and signature of recipient. Insurance on items is the owner's responsibility.

#### When may I pick up my quilt?

Entries must remain on display until the show closes on Sunday, September 28, 2008. Quilts can be picked up between 4:30 and 5:00 p.m. on that day. You must have the claim ticket to pick up your item(s).
